ABOUT THE DESERT MOUNTAIN TENNIS COMPLEX

Situated on 10 acres at the Sonoran Clubhouse, the Desert Mountain Tennis Complex features nine USTA-certified courts including Arizona's only stadium grass court, five clay (har-tru) courts and three two-toned green on green hard courts. Each court has its own pergola with misters and refrigerated, bottled water for comfortable year-round play. Members can enjoy superb playing conditions and programs for all ages, abilities and levels whether they desire a social or competitive experience. The staff also provides private and group instruction upon request.



FOR THE LADIES

SOCIAL LEVEL

- Women's Open Play is held twice weekly for all levels. This is a doubles round robin format with three rounds and is run by the tennis staff. Balls are provided and play is held on the clay courts. When needed, Desert Mountain's tennis professionals participate in open play to make the numbers even.

COMPETITIVE LEVEL

- Women's Advanced Open Play is held on Saturday mornings. This program, which continues to grow in popularity, is more competitive than the weekday groups, with levels ranging from 4.0-5.0. This is a round robin format and is held on Desert Mountain's three hard courts.
- Tennis Team League Play for ladies is available at the 3.5, 4.0, 4.5 and 5.0 levels. Currently, Desert Mountain has five teams that compete in matches at Desert Mountain and at clubs throughout the Valley. League play is flexible so members can play as much or as little as they prefer.
- Desert Mountain Ladies Day Team Event is held twice a year as a season kick-off for the ladies leagues and as an end of season party. This is a tournament-style event designed to be competitive and to bring together the league teams.

CLINICS

- Morning clinics are held pre- and post-season weekly for the 5.0 team drill.
- Afternoon clinics are held weekly throughout the season for 3.5-4.0 and 4.0-4.5 players.

FOR THE MEN

SOCIAL LEVEL

- Men's Open Play is held three days per week for all levels. This doubles round robin format with three rounds is run by the tennis staff. Balls are provided and play is held on the clay courts. When needed, Desert Mountain's tennis professionals participate in open play to make the numbers even.

MIXED

Desert Mountain holds a monthly tennis social for men and women from September through May. This mixed doubles, revolving partner format provides an opportunity to meet fellow members of all playing abilities.

JUNIOR TENNIS

Junior tennis lessons are offered every Saturday morning. Summer and holiday camps keep Desert Mountain's youngest members active, healthy and growing their game. All levels are welcome and are paired by age and ability. After school Junior Clinics are offered.
